Young scientists: undergraduate and PhD students as well as Post Docs max. 4 years after graduation from life science area: biology, molecular biology, biochemistry, genetics, medicine, pharmacy, etc. are invited for a fellowship to join Prof. Dr hab. T. Guzik research group to study novel mechanisms of hypertension with particular emphasis on the immune mechanisms of blood pressure regulation. Studies will include the investigation of the effects of chronic infections such as gingivitis on blood pressure regulation and complications of hypertension.

Candidates should have practice experience in molecular biology and an interest in human physiology and pathology. Knowledge of FACS technics will be an advantage.

The positions are for 5 years to participate in the project named „ Immune mechanisms of hypertension and vascular dysfunction – the search for new anti-hypertensive strategies“ and funded by the Foundation for Polish Science and European Regional Development Fund. Candidates wishing to start at any time up to end of May 2010 will be considered.
