Election Regulations of the Authorities

of the Students' Scientific Society JUMC for the 2025/2026 Term

§1 Election of the Board

- 1. The elections of the Board of the Students' Scientific Society JUMC for the 2025/2026 term will be held on September 29, 2025, from 6:00 AM to 9:00 PM, in an online format via Microsoft Forms in English.
- 2. Information regarding the date, form, and voting procedure has been made public in advance, in accordance with these Regulations.
- 3. The Election Committee is responsible for conducting the Board Elections, counting the votes, announcing the results, and supervising the campaign. The Committee consists of:
 - Natalia Zamorska
 - Julia Błajszczak
 - Grzegorz Sochań
- 4. During the Board Elections, two separate votes are held:
 - a) election of the Chair of the Board,
 - b) election of the Board Members.
- 5. The Chair of the Board is elected by a simple majority of votes.
 - a) Candidates must submit their candidacy no later than 7 days before the election date, i.e., by September 22, 2025, to the official STN e-mail address: **stn@cm-uj.krakow.pl**.
 - b) Any STN member who has previously served as the Chair of a Students' Research Group and has been actively involved in STN activities may stand as a candidate.
 - c) The list of candidates for the position of Chair of the Board will be announced publicly as soon as possible after the submission deadline.
- 6. Board Members are elected in the number of 10 by a simple majority of votes.
 - a) Candidates must submit their candidacies no later than 7 days before the election date, i.e., by September 22, 2025, to **stn@cm-uj.krakow.pl**.
 - b) All regular members of STN are eligible to run.

- c) The list of candidates will be announced publicly as soon as possible after the submission deadline.
- d) During the vote, each eligible voter may select a maximum of 10 candidates.
- e) The 10 candidates with the highest number of votes will become Board Members, subject to the following:
- i. If no candidate from a given Faculty secures a place on the Board, the candidate from that Faculty with the highest number of votes shall replace the candidate with the lowest score.
- ii. In the case of a tie, the decision is made by the Chair-Elect.
- 7. The newly elected Chair additionally appoints 5 Board Members outside of the electoral procedure. Their names must be submitted to the Election Committee and announced publicly no later than 5 days after the election day.
 - a) If the number of candidates in the elections is fewer than 10, the Chair has the right to appoint additional members so that the Board, together with the Chair, consists of a maximum of 15 members.

§2 Term of the Board

- 1. The term of office of the Board ends:
 - a) after one year,
 - b) as a result of the resignation or dismissal of more than 50% of the Board Members.
- 2. In the case of early termination of the term, the date of new elections is decided by the Audit Committee.
- 3. In the event of resignation or dismissal of the Chair, their duties shall be assumed by one of the current Vice-Chairs, elected by the Board, until new elections are held.
- 4. In the event of the resignation or dismissal of fewer than 50% of Board Members, by-elections are held in accordance with the rules of the main elections.

§3 Election of the Audit Committee

1. Elections of the Audit Committee are held simultaneously with the Board Elections.

Candidates must submit their candidacies to **stn@cm-uj.krakow.pl** no later than September 22, 2025.

- 3. Only those who were members of the STN Board in the previous academic year may apply.
- 4. There are 3 seats available.
- 5. Each voter casts a vote for one candidate.
- 6. The 3 candidates with the highest number of votes become members of the Audit Committee.
- 7. In the case of a tie, the decision is made by the outgoing Audit Committee.
- 8. In the event of resignation or unfilled seats, by-elections may be conducted.

§4 Campaign and Election Debate

- 1. The use of STN resources (including social media, financial or material resources, and personal data) for campaign purposes is prohibited, except in forms permitted by the Election Committee.
- 2. In the event of a violation of this rule, the Election Committee may summon the candidate for an explanation and subsequently withdraw their candidacy the decision must be documented and reviewed by the STN Supervisor.
- 3. Each candidate has the right to present their candidacy and program in a form determined by the Election Committee, equal and fair for all.
- 4. Each candidate has the right to submit a one-page campaign poster/leaflet in .pdf format, which will be distributed by the Election Committee to eligible voters using a method chosen by the Committee.
- 5. The election debate will take place prior to the election day, with the exact date announced at least 7 days in advance.

§5 Voting Procedure and Announcement of Results

- 1. Voting takes place online via Microsoft Forms.
- 2. Login is carried out using the university e-mail address.
- 3. The election results will be announced by the Election Committee no later than 5 days after the end of voting.
